## A CALL FOR VOLUNTEERS

*Dear Suffragists:*

The Connecticut Woman Suffrage Association is faced with what will probably be the most active campaign in its history. Whether the Senate delays the passage of the Suffrage Federal Amendment or not we must secure a favorable state Legislature. This will mean a campaign all through the summer and fall.

Through the kindness of generous friends we are rich in salaried workers, but it will be physically impossible for them to do the necessary work unless they are assisted by a large and *dependable* corps of volunteers. For this purpose we are issuing a call to genuine, loyal suffragists to give us special and concrete help. We are anxious to get at least eight women who will give us a month of their time, letting themselves be used how and where they are most needed. Already one woman

has volunteered a month of her time in September or October. Surely there are others in Connecticut who are so situated that they can do this.

The suffrage cause is almost won. We are in the last chapter. It will be a life long satisfaction to feel that you have done a bit of really professional work to put suffrage over the top.

If you will volunteer as a "one-month worker," without salary, will you not send in your name to Miss Daphne Selden, State Organizer, 55 Pratt Street, Hartford, who will then arrange to meet with you and decide further details.

If you cannot give a month, we also desire a large number of volunteers who will give one solid week of their time to our signature campaign. If you can do this communicate with your County Organizer in regard to it.

Come and help us. We need you.
