deceased, South East and West by Highway
and containing Eight Acres more or less

To have and to hold the premises, with all the appurtenances unto the said release, *his* heirs and assigns
forever, so that neither I the said releasor nor *my* heirs, nor any other person under *me* or
them shall hereafter have any claim, right or title in or to the premises, or any part thereof; but therefrom
I and they are by these presents forever barred and secluded.
