all right, title, interest, claim and demand whatever, which *I* the said releasor have or ought to have in or to  
a certain tract of Land situate at *Stadley*  
Nigh a place so called in *Said Danbury*  
bounded North by Land of the heirs of *Timothy*  
*Widman* deceased and South East and West  
by Highway and containing Eight Acres more  
or less -

To have and to hold the premises, with all the appurtenances unto the said release, *his* heirs and assigns  
forever, so that neither *I* the said releasor nor *my* heirs, nor any other person under *me* or  
them shall hereafter have any claim, right or title in or to the premises, or any part thereof; but therefrom  
*I* and they are by these presents forever barred and secluded.
