all right, title, interest, claim, and demand whatever, which I the said releasor have or ought to have in or to
the following described tract of Land with the buildings standing thereon
situate in said Darien viz One tract on Dix Hill with all the buildings standing
thereon bounded South and West by Highway East by Elias Stansbury land
and North by William Montgomery's land containing One acre more or less
also one other tract of Land situate at the foot of Dix Hill so called
bounded South by Highway East by Highway North by Elijah Gregory
land and West by Eli Wildman or Isa Diteman's land my intention
being to include in this last named tract of Land all of the land which
I purchased of Capt Elijah Gregory & also three other tracts of Land
situate at Mill Brook, one piece bounded South by Samuel Kist
mes land, East by Lydia Scitman's land North and West by David An
dles land, the second piece bounded South and North by Lydia Scit
man's land West by Thomas Wildman's land and East by Lydia Scit
man's land the other piece bounded South by John & Lydia Scitman
land East by Land now or formerly of Abram Banks North by
Land now or late of Thomas Wildman & West by Lydia Scitman's land
the said three tracts of Land containing Thirteen acres more or less it
being my intention hereby to convey all of the land which I own
or possess in said Mill Brook district or in said Mill Brook
so called or in the Town of Ridgebury in the Town of Ridgefield

To have and to hold the premises, with all the appurtenances unto the said releasee & his heirs and assigns for.

shall hereafter have any claim, right or title in or to the premises, or any part thereof; but therefrom L and
they are by these presents forever barred and secluded.
