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## HISTORICAL SKETCH.

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The First Ecclesiastical Society of Bethel, was organized November 12, 1759, the society having its legal origin<sup>1</sup> in an act of the General Assembly of Connecticut, passed the October before.

The church was organized November 25, 1760, which consisted of seventy-one persons, duly recommended from the church in Danbury. At this date the church was recognized by a council of the Eastern Consociation of Fairfield County, of which Rev. David Judson of Newtown, was moderator. This council also ordained as pastor of the church, Mr. Noah Wetmore, a licentiate, Rev. Ebenezer White of Danbury, preaching the sermon. Articles of belief and a covenant were adopted. Deacons were not appointed until the following February, when Capt. John

Benedict, and Capt. Ebenezer Hickok, were ordained with the laying on of hands.

The first thirty years in the history of the church presents a struggle against peculiar hindrances, which tested its life and the spirit of the brethren who founded it. Its most severe test was under the practice, common with the churches of the colony, of admitting to its membership persons who sought the rights of citizenship only, or "The Half-Way Covenant," as it was called.<sup>2</sup> Theological controversy, originating in the preaching of Robert Sandeman, was disturbing this and the neighboring churches. The colony was suffering from the burdens of the Revolutionary War, and particularly this locality. In the year 1775, a malignant disease caused the death of more than fifty members of the society. It was found at the close of Rev. Mr. Wetmore's ministry, that the roll of the church had decreased from the original seventy-one members to thirty-six, but these had confessed the *full* covenant.

The details of these earlier years of trial, and the succeeding years of growth and progress, are preserved in the admirable centennial discourse of Rev. L. P. Hickok, D.D., preached November 30, 1860.

#### PLACES OF WORSHIP.

At the first meeting of the society, November 12, 1760, measures were taken to provide for a place of worship, and for a preacher of the Gospel. Capt. Ebenezer Hickok gave the society land for a site for a meeting-house, and sufficient land for a burial-ground. The meeting-house

was completed, so far as to be occupied the following summer, and was located in part upon the site of our present house of worship. The house remained unfinished in its interior until the year 1796, when pews were added, a pulpit and the gallery. A steeple was erected in 1818, and a bell procured ten years later. In the year 1832, extensive repairs were made and slips substituted for pews. This building was burned July 21, 1842. A second and larger house of worship was erected in the year following, and dedicated June 1st, Rev. James Knox preaching the dedicatory sermon. During a gale of wind in the spring of 1865, the house was injured by the falling of the spire, and was not further used for purposes of worship. Having been repaired, it was sold to the town, and now stands a few rods west of its former site. The third and present house of worship was erected in the year 1866, and has been refitted from time to time, as the increasing demands of the parish required.

A parsonage was built in the year 1850, which was occupied for fifteen years, when it was sold and a second property purchased. This latter was occupied for three years and was likewise sold. The present parsonage, on Chestnut street, was built by the society in the autumn of the year 1873, and enlarged in the year 1883.

#### THE CHOIR.

The service of praise in our worship has been maintained from the earlier years of our history. There are those still living who remember the choir of fifty years ago, under the leadership of Daniel Taylor, when they "chanted to the sound of the viol" as played by Apollos Benedict. It was later, and under the leadership of Ransom Seelye,

that the singers "invented to themselves instruments of music like David"; Hiram Benjamin played upon the bass-viol; Deacon Matthew Starr upon the flute, and Edward Stapleton upon the clarionet, and they did "make a joyful noise to the God of Jacob." Among the choristers of recent years, Henry Squires is especially remembered. The present efficient chorister, Mrs. George H. Hickok, has served as organist or chorister, or in both capacities at the same time, since 1868; and William F. Sherman presides at the organ with acceptance.

A small reed organ was introduced about the year 1855, and, although regarded by some at the time as a bold innovation, came to maintain its place. The pipe organ, now in use, was built by Johnson & Sons of Westfield, Mass., and was placed in the church building in the summer of 1881.

#### TIMES OF REFRESHING.

In the year 1790, under the preaching of Samuel Sturges, a licentiate, a deep spiritual interest was awakened and within a few months twenty-four persons united with the church by profession, greatly strengthening the little flock in the hour of weakness. During the year 1831, a continuous revival interest prevailed and fifty-seven confessed their faith. The most marked ingathering, in the history of the church was in 1843, following the brief period of labor with the church, of Rev. James Knox; on a single sabbath in June of this year, one hundred and nineteen united with the church by confession. The year 1852, under the labors of Rev. Samuel Underwood; the years 1855 and 1858, of Rev. Mr. Harvey's pastorate; the year 1874 of the pastorate of Rev. Mr. Waters; and the year 1885 of the present pastorate, were years of marked

Divine blessing and bore rich spiritual fruits. Two years only have been passed during the last half century without additions to the roll of the church.

#### THE GOSPEL MINISTRY.

The church has rejoiced in its sons who have entered the Gospel ministry. Their names, so far as known, are Rev. Messrs. Ebenezer Platt; Laurens P. Hickok; Bennett F. Northrop; Dennis Platt; George Barnum; John L. Ambler; Samuel T. Seelye; Julius H. Seelye; Laurens Clark Seelye; Theodore Benjamin; Henry Lobdell; Pliny S. Smith; Arthur J. Benedict, who labored in Congregational or Presbyterian churches; Rev. Messrs. Levi Peck, Nathan Benedict, George S. Judd, and Horace Q. Judd, entered other connections. These have been identified with our church or Sabbath-school.

#### THE SABBATH-SCHOOL.

The first Sabbath-school connected with the church, so far as known, was that organized in the summer of 1818, by Rev. Burr Baldwin. Deacon Seth Seelye, during the following summer, gathered a school of from thirty to fifty members, providing for it a small library. In the years which have succeeded, the school has been continuously sustained, increasing in numerical strength with the growth of the church. The following brethren have held the office of superintendent: Dea. Seth Seelye; Dea. Elizur Benedict; Frederick Seelye; Andrew C. Hickok; Ezekiel Drew; Charles Dart; Dea. George A. Hickok; David T. Hubbell; Augustus A. Fisher; Frank W. Smith; Dea. William A. Judd; Dea. Andrew L. Benedict, and Dea. Charles Bailey, the last of whom is still faithfully serving the school.

**SUPPLIES AND ACTING PASTORS.**

Forty-one of the one hundred and twenty-seven years since its organization, the church has been served by ministers who were not regularly installed over it. The pastorless condition of the church has at times resulted in great discouragement. But some of those who have supplied the church have labored with marked acceptance. The Rev. Joseph Peck acted as supply, at intervals, for several years, after pastor Wetmore had closed his labors. This was during years of great spiritual depression. He lived however to witness the earlier fruits of the first revival of religion the church enjoyed, under Mr. Sturges' labors. He died May 19, 1791, aged fifty-seven, and was buried in the old cemetery near the church.

At the close of Rev. Mr. Sturges' pastorate, the church was without a pastor for ten years. Among the many supplies during this interval, Rev. Jonathan Bartlett, a preacher of more than ordinary ability, is remembered; also Rev. John Noyes, and Rev. Benjamin Fenn, who were especially acceptable ministers of Christ. Rev. Abel B. Burke preached in the church in the spring of 1843, preparing the way for the great work of grace of that year, in which Rev. James Knox was the human leader. Mr. Knox began to preach in early summer, when the "Great Awakening" as it was called, began.

Rev. Lent S. Hough served the church with acceptance in 1845; Rev. Samuel Underwood, in 1852, and Rev. Newell A. Prince, in 1859. In July, 1865, Rev. Gustavus L. Foster was unanimously called to the pastorate of the church. Although never formally installed, Mr. Foster served the church faithfully as an under shepherd for two years, closing his labors October 1, 1867, when he was

succeeded by Rev. George A. Pelton. Mr. Pelton's ministry continued until the spring of 1869, and was distinguished, as was the preceding ministry, by continuous spiritual progress, seventy-one being admitted to the church during these two brief terms of service.

#### PASTORS.

The average pastorate of the church has been seven years. Rev. Mr. Wetmore's term of service was the longest, twenty-four years; which was followed by the pastorate of Rev. Mr. Ely of twelve and one-half years. The briefest term of service was that of Rev. Mr. Haight, who served the church for only sixteen months.

## DEACONS.

The practice of electing deacons for undefined terms of service continued until 1873, when the term of service was fixed and made to cover four years of service; this term of service was extended, by vote of church, December 10, 1885, to a term of six years service. The following is the record of those who have served the church from its organization :

## STANDING RULES.

Adopted Dec. 10, 1885.

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*Consociation.*—This church, in all matters pertaining to fellowship with sister churches, or requiring an Ecclesiastical Council, shall consider itself identified with the Consociation of Fairfield East.

*Officers.*—The officers of this church shall be a pastor, six acting deacons, a clerk, a treasurer of the church, a treasurer of the benevolent funds, and a church committee; the pastor to be chosen whenever, and to hold his office as long as the interests of the church require; the deacons to be chosen, one every year, and to hold their office six years; the other officers to be chosen annually.

*Business Meetings.*—The annual meeting shall be held during the last week of the year. Special business meetings shall be notified from the pulpit on the Sabbath, and shall be called by the pastor or by the deacons or by the consent of four of the members. The voting upon letters of dismission, or the reception of members, may be done at the preparatory lecture.

*Election of Officers.*—The annual meeting shall be the time, ordinarily, for the election of officers. The deacons shall be chosen by ballot. The other officers shall be chosen upon nomination, unless objection is made, when the choice shall be by ballot.

*Duties of Deacons.*—It shall be the duty of the deacons to assist in the administration of the Lord's Supper, to dispense the funds collected for the poor of the church, and to aid the pastor generally in the spiritual care of the flock.

*Duties of Clerk.*—It shall be the duties of the clerk to keep the records of the church, and the minutes of all business transactions, to issue citations, write letters of dismission and recommendation, and to do such other correspondence as may be ordered by the church.

*Duties of Treasurers.*—It shall be the duty of the treasurer of the church to take charge of the funds collected for the poor, and for church expenditure, disburse the same as authorized by the deacons, and give his account in a report to be read at the annual meeting. The treasurer of the benevolent funds, with the advice of the pastor and deacons, shall annually prepare a scheme of objects for successive Sabbath-day offerings which shall be presented to each member of the congregation. All sums pledged and given shall be received by him and credited to the various givers in a book kept by himself. These amounts in detail shall be given in his annual report, and it shall be his duty to see that all sums contributed go to the objects designated by the donors.

*The Church Committee.*—This committee shall consist of the pastor, deacons, and from two to five brethren; the pastor being moderator, or, in his absence, the senior deacon. It shall be the duty of this committee to examine all persons who offer themselves for admission to the church, and to declare who shall be propounded as suitable candidates. They are also at liberty to deliberate and determine in regard to all such matters connected with the good of the church, as may seem to them reasonable and judicious.

*Discipline.*—This church holds it to be a solemn and important duty, to attend watchfully to the discipline which Christ has instituted in His church. In all cases of private offenses, the rule, as given in the eighteenth chapter of Matthew's Gospel, is to be strictly observed. In cases of public and notorious offenses, against the laws of religion and morality, any person may take the first and second steps of discipline, when the church, as a body, may proceed to call the offender to an account, by a committee appointed for that purpose. The church may, after due notice has been given to the parties, withdraw watch and

care from the same, without public trial. Excommunication shall be the concluding form of censure decreed by the church. Members of this church removing from the bounds thereof are expected to ask for letters of dismission and recommendation to some other church. Absent members not asking for letters of dismission, after one year's absence, shall be *admonished by the clerk*, and, unless they ask for letters within six months after such notice, or give reason for not so doing, satisfactory to the church committee, the church by vote may withdraw the watch and care of the church from such members.

*Admission of Members.*—Applicants for admission to membership by letter, having been approved by the church committee, shall be propounded from the pulpit one week before the vote as to their admission be taken. Applicants for admission on profession shall be propounded at least one week before the Communion, and, if no objection has been made, shall then be received.

*Members of Other Churches.*—Members of other Christian churches, who join with us stately, in public worship, and Christian ordinances, are expected to become members of this church by presenting letters of dismission and recommendation from the churches to which they belong.

*Dismission of Members.*—Requests for letters of dismission must be announced to the church one week before they are granted. The rule requiring candidates to be propounded before admission, may be suspended by a vote of the church.

*The Lord's Supper.*—The ordinance of the Lord's Supper shall be administered on the first Sabbath of every alternate month, beginning at January. At the close of this service, a collection shall be taken up in behalf of the poor of the parish, and for contingent expenses. The preparatory lecture shall be left discretionary with the pastor. Stated meetings for prayer and conference shall be held at such times as the pastor and deacons direct.

## FORM OF ADMISSION TO THE CHURCH.<sup>1</sup>

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What shall I render unto the Lord for all His benefits toward me ?

I will take the cup of salvation, and call upon the name of the Lord.

I will pay my vows unto the Lord now in the presence of all His people.—

*Ps. cxvi. : 12-14.*

Whosoever therefore shall confess me before men, him will I confess also before My Father which is in heaven.

But whosoever shall deny Me before men, him will I also deny before My Father which is in heaven.—*Matt. x. : 32-33.*

For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness ; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.—*Rom. x. : 10.*

Dearly beloved, called of God to be His children through Jesus Christ, our Lord ; you are here that, in the presence of God and His people, you may confess your faith in Christ and enter into the fellowship and communion of His Church.

You will listen to the confession of faith of this Church, to which we ask your assent :

### CONFESSTION OF FAITH.

I. We believe in one God, the Father Almighty, Maker of heaven and earth, and of things visible and invisible; Who is infinite in holiness, wisdom, and love; and in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord, who is one with the Father; by whom all things are made; and in the Holy Spirit, the Lord and Giver of life, who is sent from the Father and the Son, and who, together with the

Father and Son, is worshiped and glorified; that these three persons are one in essence and council.

II. We believe that the Providence of God, by which He executes His eternal purposes in the government of the world, is in and over all events; yet so that the freedom and responsibility of man are not impaired and sin is the act of the creature alone.

III. We believe that the scriptures of the Old and New Testaments were given by inspiration of God, and are a perfect rule of faith and practice.

IV. We believe God made man upright and holy, but that he sinned and fell; and that, since the fall, all have become wholly sinners both in heart and practice, and cannot be restored to Divine favor without an atonement for sin.

V. We believe that the Lord Jesus Christ, having taken upon Himself our nature, has, by His obedience, sufferings, and death, provided a way of salvation for all mankind; and that through repentance and faith in His name, whosoever will may be saved.

VI. We believe that Jesus Christ sends the Holy Spirit to convict men of sin, and to lead them to repentance and faith, and that all who accept Christ are renewed in heart, forgiven their sins, and are made children of God; that these by fellowship with Christ, the indwelling of the Holy Spirit and obedience to truth, will grow in sanctified character; and that the believer's hope of continuance in such a life, is in the persevering grace of God.

VII. We believe that Christ has established a visible Church, comprising all true believers, whose duty it is to associate themselves together for the maintenance of wor-

ship, for the promotion of spiritual growth and fellowship and for the conversion of men; that Baptism and the Lord's Supper are ordinances of the Church of Divine institution, to be observed by the people of God until the end of time.

VIII. We believe in the observance of the Christian Sabbath, to be kept sacred as a day of holy rest and worship.

IX. We believe in the Resurrection of the dead; that God in Christ will judge the world; that the wicked shall go away into eternal punishment, but the righteous into eternal life.

These things you solemnly profess to believe?

[Baptism may here be administered.]

Dearly beloved, having given assent to the articles which we confess, you will take upon you the sacred engagement of our Covenant :

#### COVENANT.

In the presence of Almighty God and this Church, you do truly repent of your sins; you do heartily receive Jesus Christ as your crucified Saviour and risen Lord; you consecrate yourself (or yourselves) unto God and your life to His service; you accept His word as your law and His Spirit as your Comforter and Guide; and, trusting in his Grace to confirm and strengthen you in all goodness, you promise to do God's holy will, to maintain a life of prayer, to study the Scriptures, to keep his ordinances, and to walk with this Church in the peace of our Lord Jesus Christ.

You do join with ancient saints, with the Church

throughout the world, and with us, your fellow-believers, in humbly confessing your faith in the Gospel, saying:

I believe in God, the Father Almighty, Maker of heaven and earth, and in Jesus Christ His only Son our Lord; who was conceived by the Holy Ghost, born of the virgin Mary; suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, dead, and buried; the third day He rose from the dead; He ascended into heaven; and sitteth at the right hand of God the Father Almighty; from thence He shall come to judge the quick and the dead. I believe in the Holy Ghost; the Holy catholic Church; the communion of saints; the forgiveness of sins; the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.

[Those uniting with the church by letter should rise.]

Confessing the Lord whom we unitedly worship, you do now renew your self-consecration, and join with us heartily in this, our Christian faith and covenant.

[Members of the church should rise.]

We welcome you into our fellowship. [Giving right hand] we promise to watch over you with Christian love. God grant that, loving and being loved, serving and being served, blessing and being blessed, we may be prepared together on earth, for the perfect communion of saints in heaven.

“ Now the God of peace, that brought again from the dead our Lord Jesus, that great Shepherd of the sheep, through the blood of the everlasting covenant, make you perfect in every good work to do His will, working in you that which is well-pleasing in His sight, through Jesus Christ; to whom be glory for ever and ever.” Amen.

## **FORM OF INFANT BAPTISM.**

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You are about to dedicate your child [or children] to God in Baptism. You do therefore solemnly promise and covenant, should life be spared, to teach, or cause it to be taught to read the Word of God; to instruct it in the principles of the Religion of Christ; to make it acquainted with its duty, and the obligation to discharge it; to pray with and for it; to endeavor in all respects to set before it a godly example, and in all the appointed means to train it up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.

These things, relying upon God for help, you do now promise to perform.

### Soldiers who Served in the War of the Rebellion.

Fifty-one men, so far as known, entered the service of their country during the civil war, from families connected with this parish. Twenty-two of these were members of the church, and their names are as follows:

Three of these lost their lives in the service: Leonard D. Smith, who was killed at the battle of Cedar Mountain, Va.; Irenæus P. Woodman, who was mortally wounded in the battle of Chancellorsville, Va., and William H. Holley, who died in Salsbury prison. The other persons mentioned are still living,—twenty-two years after the close of the war. Rev. Mr. Whittlesey, a pastor of this church 1849–1852, was the chaplain of an Iowa regiment, and died from over-taxing his strength in caring for the wounded after the battle of Pittsburg Landing.
