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STANDING RULES.

[The Chapel Street Congregational Church was organized November 4th, 1838. The following Rules, Confession of Faith, and Covenant, were adopted on the 12th of January, 1841.]

RULE I.—No person shall be admitted a member of this Church on a profession of religion, until he has been examined by a committee chosen by the brethren for that purpose; and on such examination is believed to be a sincere follower of Christ; and every candidate for admission shall stand propounded to the Church for one month, and to the Congregation for two weeks, before he is received.

II.—Every person wishing to unite with us from a neighboring Church, shall exhibit his dismission from the Church with which he has been connected, and such testimonials of his character as are satisfactory. If it is thought necessary, he shall be examined by a Committee of this Church, as to his faith, his knowledge of Christian doctrine, and his personal piety. He shall subscribe the confession of faith agreed upon by this Church; and before a vote is taken, he shall stand propounded for admission to the communion of this Church for one month.

III.—This Church consider Christian Discipline as a most important duty established by the Lord Jesus Christ; and that every church must expect the Divine blessing, in some measure as the members are faithful in attending to the purity of the church, and in watching over the daily walk of each individual member. Therefore, in all cases of private offences, the rule given in the eighteenth chapter of Matthew's Gospel, is to be strictly observed; but in cases of public and notorious offenses against the laws of religion and morality, the church as a body must proceed to call the offender to an account, in that manner which shall be considered most agreeable to the directions of the gospel.

IV.—This Church does not recognize any Ecclesiastical Court except a particular Church as of divine appointment. When our Savior gives the law in the case of private offences, he says relative to an offending brother, "but if he neglect to hear the church, let him be unto thee as a

heathen man and a publican." As Christ has not commanded or authorized any appeal to a higher court in this case, and as he has mentioned no one, this church consider all such courts to be of human appointment, and their acts as not binding on the conscience of any Christian; yet, as advisory bodies, they think they may be, and are, in many cases useful.

V.—Every member of this church shall be considered as in the fellow-ship, and under the watch and discipline of the church, until regularly dismissed. But whenever any brother, or sister, in regular standing, shall, with a good conscience, believe that his or her growth in grace will be promoted by a dismission from this to another church; (which church we consider as founded upon the Apostles and Prophets, Jesus Christ himself being the chief corner stone,) and shall apply for dismission, then we will give a letter of dismission and recommendation in the customary manner.

VI.—Whenever, in the providence of God, a minister, or a candidate for the ministry, is invited to take the oversight of this church, and become its Pastor; then it is the wish of the church that he should subscribe the confession of faith, and unite himself to this church as one of the brethren, and be subject to its watch and discipline in all matters of vice and immorality; agreeably to the spirit and precepts of the Gospel, and to the primitive custom of the churches in this town, and in this State.

VII.—All business before the church shall be determined by a majority of the votes of the members present; and the chairman shall have a casting vote, should the votes of the members at any time be equally divided. The Pastor of the church shall be the Chairman, when present; if he is absent, the oldest Deacon present shall preside; if no Deacon be present, then a Chairman shall be elected by a majority of votes.

VIII.—A Standing Committee shall be annually elected by the Church, who, in addition to presenting cases of discipline, shall, together with the Pastor and Deacons, examine and recommend persons who wish to unite with the Church.

IX.—No alteration or amendment shall be made in this constitution, or in the confession of faith, adopted by this church, unless by the votes of two-thirds of the members present in a church meeting especially called for that purpose.

CONFESSION OF FAITH.

ARTICLE I.—We believe in the one, only living and true God, the Father, the Son, and the Holy Ghost; who is a spirit, infinite, eternal, and unchangeable, in his being, power, knowledge, presence, wisdom, holiness, justice, goodness, and truth; that it is the duty of all his intelligent creatures to serve and to worship him, in spirit and in truth; that he created all things; that he preserves and governs all his creatures, and overrules all their actions for his own glory: and that in whatsoever comes to pass, he is accomplishing his eternal purposes, according to the counsel of his own will, in such a way, that man is a free agent, and accountable for all his actions.

ART. II.—We believe that God created man upright; that our first parents freely sinned and fell, and that all mankind in a state of nature, and before regeneration by the Spirit of God, are dead in trespasses and sins, without holiness and true love to God, and are justly exposed to all the miseries of this life, and to the pains of hell forever.

ART. III.—We believe that God in his mercy has not left all mankind to perish forever, but out of his mere good pleasure, has, from all eternity, chosen some to everlasting life; and that he has covenanted to deliver them from sin and misery, and to bring them into a state of salvation by a Redeemer; that he has "so loved the world that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life;" and that "whosoever will," may "take the water of life freely."

ART. IV.—We believe that the only Redeemer of men is the Lord Jesus Christ, who is very God, and very man; that taking upon him our nature, he freely suffered and died on the cross, making atonement for sin; that he arose from the dead, and ascended into heaven, where he ever liveth to make intercession for

his people; that "there is none other name, under heaven, given among men, whereby we must be saved;" and that all who are saved are justified through faith in the Lord Jesus Christ.

ART. V.—We believe that without a change of heart wrought in the unregenerate, by the special divine agency of the Holy Spirit, who is very God, no one can be an heir of eternal life; and that the soul which is once made partaker of renewing and saving grace, will never be permitted so to fall away, as finally to perish.

ART. VI.—We believe that those who, having been chosen by God, are brought to repentance and justified through faith, are also sanctified by the Spirit through the truth, and by adoption, made the sons of God, and heirs of eternal life.

ART. VII.—We believe that repentance, justification, adoption, sanctification, and perseverance, are not bestowed as the reward of any merit in him who receives them, but all flow from the free and unmerited grace of God.

ART. VIII.—We believe that there will be a general resurrection of the righteous and the wicked, and a general judgment, at which all the righteous will be admitted to everlasting happiness, and all the wicked sentenced to misery without end.

ART. IX.—We believe that the Sacraments of the Christian Church are Baptism and the Lord's Supper; and that the infant children of believing parents are proper subjects of Christian Baptism.

ART. X.—We believe that the Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments are given by the inspiration of God, and are the sufficient and only rule of faith and practice.

Such is the belief of this Church—do you cordially assent to these Articles of Faith?

Having read and carefully considered the Articles of Faith subscribed by this Church, you do hereby signify your belief in the same, as the doctrines contained in the Scriptures of the Old and New Testament.

COVENANT.

You do now, in the presence of God and this assembly, solemnly, and as you hope, with sincerity, dedicate yourselves to God in Christ, humbly confessing and repenting of your sins.

You publicly acknowledge and choose the only living and true God to be your God, the Lord Jesus Christ your Redeemer, and the Holy Spirit your Sanctifier.

You covenant and promise, that by the strength of divine grace, you will make it your endeavor to deny all ungodliness and worldly lusts, and to live soberly, righteously and godly, in this present world; hoping that you have a love of benevolence toward all mankind; and intending to do good as you have opportunity, especially to those of the household of faith.

You also covenant with this Church, that so long as you continue a member of the same, you will walk with it in Christian fellowship and affection, and in a due attendance upon all the institutions of Christ.

Thus, in the presence of God, you solemnly covenant and promise.

Then doth this Church likewise promise you, that, through the help of Christ, we will walk towards you in Christian watchfulness, charity, and brotherly love.
