HISTORICAL SKETCH.

ACCORDING to authentic records, the first settlement was made in what is now the town of Enfield, in the year 1679. A formal grant of the township was made to nine individuals in 1681, and in 1683 the town was incorporated by the name of Enfield. But it was under the jurisdiction of *Massachusetts* until 1720; at which time, upon the petition of a number of persons to the Legislature of *Connecticut*, it was attached to Connecticut.

A prominent condition in the original grant, was, that the grantees "adopt measures as soon as possible for the maintenance of Christian ordinances; and for the support of an able, orthodox ministry." And "It was ordered and determined that full sixty or seventy acres of land or more, be set apart for the ministry; and to be improved for the use of the church in Enfield, and to be continued for that use forever; and not be granted away from the ministry, or such as shall be the settled preachers of God's word in the place, forever."

In 1684 a small house was erected for the worship of God, adapted to their present ability and necessity. In 1706, a more convenient house was built; yet this was not large, as may be seen from the traces of its foundation which are still visible, measuring twenty feet square. In 1775, the third house of worship was built, which having been once thoroughly repaired, remains to this time. The dimensions of the latter house are—length 72½ feet, breadth 45½, height to the eaves, 28, and of the steeple about 90 feet.

The church was organized, probably, about the time the town was incorporated. No record of the earliest proceedings have been found, nor of the names of the original members. Tradition says, the first minister that officiated was the *Rev.*

Mr. Welch ; but his labors soon closed with his death. The *Rev. Nathaniel Collins* was regularly installed 1699. He officiated as Pastor twenty-five years, and was succeeded by *Rev. Peter Reynolds*. Mr. Reynolds entered upon his charge November, 1725, and continued till his death, 1768, *Æ.* 68. In 1769 *Rev. Elam Potter* was ordained, and continued the Pastor about seven years, and was dismissed.

During Mr. Potter's ministry in this place, an excitement broke out respecting church order ; and in 1770 a new Society was formed, called the *Second Ecclesiastical Society* of Enfield. Their object was to secure the ends of *strict Congregationalism*, as they understand the term ; and they were of the class now known in the history of that period, as *Separates* or *Separatists*. Most of the members of this Society are now dead, or have removed.

After Mr. Potter's dismissal, the people were in a divided state, and the church remained destitute of a pastor more than six years. *Rev. Nehemiah Pruden* was ordained November, 1782, and officiated till his death, September, 1815. *Rev. Francis L. Robbins*, was ordained April 24th, 1816.

THE CONFESSION OF FAITH.

You do believe ; there is one only living and true God ; Father, Son, and Holy Ghost.

That the Scriptures of the Old and New Testament, are the word of God, and the rule of Christian faith and practice :

That God entered into a covenant of works with man, on condition of perfect obedience :— That our first parents by eating the forbidden fruit, brought themselves and all their posterity into a state of sin and misery :

But God out of his mere mercy, sent his only begotten Son, who in our nature hath borne the curse, and answered the law for us :

That all who believe in Him are justified, and shall be kept, by the power of God, through faith unto salvation :

That at the last day, the Lord Jesus Christ will descend from heaven and condemn all ungodly men to eternal punishment, with the Devil and his angels ; and receive his saints to a kingdom prepared for them before the foundation of the world.

THE COVENANT USED IN THIS CHURCH.

You, and each of you, for yourselves respectively, do, in an everlasting covenant, now give up yourselves to God in Jesus Christ; you do humbly and penitently ask of God, forgiveness through the blood of Christ, for all your sins; and with all your heart you do accept of Jesus Christ for your Redeemer and only Saviour, as he is offered to poor sinners in the Gospel.

You do likewise promise before God, the holy angels, and in the presence of this assembly, that being helped by the Holy Spirit, you will forsake the vanities of this evil world, and approve yourselves the true disciples of Jesus Christ, in all good courage towards God and man.

Particularly you promise, so long as God shall continue you among us, to walk in communion with the church of Christ in this place, subjecting yourselves to the discipline of Christ in it; promising by His grace to live devoted to Him all your days, in a faithful obedience to all his holy Commandments.

This you promise.

I then in the name of Christ declare you, and each of you, to be members in full communion with this Church of Christ, and in the name of the Church I promise, that being helped by the same Divine Spirit, we will carry it towards you, as towards a member (or members) of the same body with ourselves — watching over you for your good; and that with a spirit of meekness, love, and tenderness; — asking your prayers that God would delight to dwell among us, that he would give efficacy to the means used for the edification of saints, and for the instruction and conversion of sinners; and that he would advance his kingdom here, by daily gathering souls to himself.
