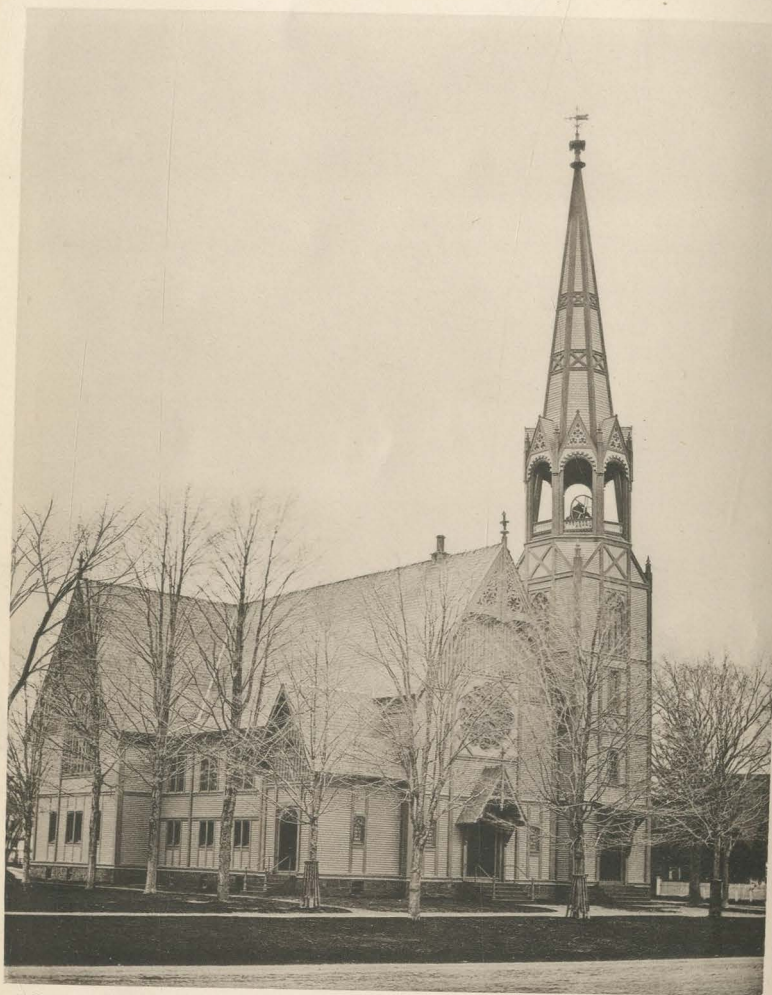

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HISTORICAL SKETCH.*

The precise date of this, the first Church of Christ in Stratford, and the names of the original members, cannot be ascertained. All business relative to the settlement, support, and dismissal of ministers, and to the building and repairing of meeting-houses, was transacted in town-meeting until the year 1721, and no regular town record, prior to 1650, exists.

Nor does any record of the Church, prior to 1675, now exist. The settlement of the town began in 1639, and took definite form as a plantation in 1640. In all probability the Church was organized as early as this, for the Rev. Adam Blakeman, its first pastor, was then in the town, as his presence is certified by an order of the General Court, dated June, 1640, directing him and others to settle the boundary line between Stratford and Fairfield.

The Church was certainly in existence in 1644, as in that year the General Court appointed William Judson and John Hurd, "members of the Stratford Church," to collect the contributions for indigent students at Cambridge College.

Since its organization this Church has had seventeen settled pastors, of whom a brief sketch of each in the order of their succession is given below.

*This sketch is taken substantially from materials gathered by Rev. B. L. Swan, while pastor of this Church.

Rev. ADAM BLAKEMAN was born in Staffordshire, Eng., A.D. 1599, and was matriculated at Christ's College, Oxford, May 28, 1617. He was a preacher for some years in Leicestershire and Derbyshire, and in 1638 came to New England. He was one of the original company of settlers in Stratford in 1639-40, and was minister of the Church until his death, September 7, 1665. Just previous to his death, the 20th of April of that year, the Rev. Israel Chauncey became, by vote of the town, his assistant. Mr. Blakeman held a prominent position among the Colonial ministers. Cotton Mather says (*Magnalia*, B'k 3d, Chap. 7,) that many of his people came with him to this country, and that Hooker once remarked, "If I might have my choice I would live and die under Mr. Blakeman's ministry."

Rev. ISRAEL CHAUNCEY was a native of Massachusetts, and the son of Rev. Charles Chauncey, President of Harvard College. He was born at Scituate, Mass., 1644, graduated at Harvard College, 1661, was chosen assistant to Mr. Blakeman in the ministry, and upon Mr. Blakeman's death was called, in June 1666, to the pastoral charge. He probably studied medicine as well as theology for a period after his graduation, for while settled over this Church he was not only appointed Chaplain to the army, but, as it is recorded in the Colonial History—"The council appointed Mr. Chauncey to be one of the council of the army in the room of Mr. Hooker, and also that he should go forth with the army as their Chirurgion." On the blank leaf of the only manuscript sermon now preserved are written two of his medical prescriptions.

Mr. Chauncey had the reputation of being a very learned, able, and devoted pastor.

Professor Kingsley says—"He had a high reputation for scholarship." He was one of the founders of Yale College, and was, probably, the presiding officer at the first meeting of those interested in its formation, as his name stands first upon the list.

He was chosen Rector or President of the College, Nov. 11, 1701, but the honor he declined. He died March 4, 1703.

Upon Mr. Chauncey's settlement, an active opposition developed itself, which culminated in the division of the Church. The seceders, after a protracted controversy, which embroiled the spiritual peace of the whole colony, became organized under the ministry of Rev. Zechariah Walker, who was ordained their pastor, May 5, 1670.

He, with his flock, soon after, in 1672, removed to colonize what is now the town of Woodbury.

After Mr. Chauncey's death, the church and town, in April, 1703, "chose Capt. Judson and the two deacons to supply the pulpit, and to obtain help of the elders of the County to keep a day of fasting and prayer for God's direction in seeking a minister." For six years the church was without a settled pastor.

A call was extended to Rev. TIMOTHY CUTLER, D.D., Sept. 16, 1709, and in or near the December of that year he was ordained. He was born in Charlestown, Mass., June 1, 1684, and graduated at Harvard College in 1701. "He was reputed as the most celebrated preacher of the Colony," and during the ten years of his pastoral office was held in high esteem. In 1719 he was chosen President of Yale College, and the "appointment was considered auspicious for the institution, for he was a man of profound and general learning." In 1722, professing a

preference for the Church of England, and renouncing his connection with the churches of the Colony, he was requested to resign his position as President of the College. Soon after, he was settled over Christ Church in Boston. He died Aug. 17, 1765.

Soon after the dismissal of Dr. Cutler, in 1719, a call was extended to Rev. Samuel Russel, (grad. Yale Col. 1712,) but as there was a large minority in opposition to him he did not settle, though, for three years he supplied the pulpit and had the pastoral care of the Church. In November, 1721, for the first time in the settlement of the town, the town as such ceased to determine, by vote, the affairs of the Congregational parish. This change arose from the introduction of an Episcopal Church, which, although it had been in embryo for some years previous, took permanent form now through accessions derived from the controversy with Mr. Russel.

In February, 1722, in view of the condition of the Church, and of the "present sickness and many sudden deaths," a day of fasting and prayer was appointed. The next day, (Thursday,) by a unanimous vote, a call was extended to Rev. HEZEKIAH GOLD. He was the son of Nathan Gold, of Fairfield, (Dep. Gov., 1707, and Chief Justice, 1712,)—was born 1694, and graduated at Harvard College 1719, and was ordained over the Church on the first Wednesday in June, 1722. His ministry was distinguished by numerous accessions to the Church. In 1722-3, sixty persons, and from 1731 to 1746, two hundred and sixty-four persons were received. Among these were the Rev. Nathan Birdsey, who died in 1818, in his 104th year, and David Wooster (afterwards General).

President Edwards, in his account of the "Great Awak-

ening," makes honorable mention of Mr. Gold and his ministry.

On Monday afternoon, October 27, 1740, Mr. Whitefield preached for Mr. Gold. His text was—"Turn ye to the stronghold, ye prisoners of hope." The sermon was blessed to the conversion of several souls.

Difficulties arising from the restiveness of opponents of what was termed "New Light Proceedings," *i. e.* of the Revival preaching and methods of that day, at length culminated in the dismissal of Mr. Gold, July 3, 1752. He died in 1761.

REV. IZRAIAH WETMORE was the son of Hezekiah Wetmore of Middletown, was born in 1728, was graduated at Yale, 1748, and was ordained pastor over this Church May 16, 1753. He was active and zealous in the affairs of his country, and during the Revolution, from its very commencement, preached earnestly and boldly for its Independence. His sermons are preserved in large numbers. He resigned his charge in 1780, and is said to have expected an appointment to the Presidency of Yale College. In 1785 he was settled over the church in Trumbull. He died in 1798. He lies buried, as does also Mr. Gold, in the burial ground of Stratford.

Again was the church left pastorless, and now for a period of four years and four months.

REV. STEPHEN WILLIAM STEBBINS was the son of Stephen Stebbins; was born in East Long Meadow, Mass., June 26, 1758, and was graduated at Yale College 1781. He was ordained pastor of this Church, July 7, 1784. Just before his ordination the Church made declaration of In-

dependency and reaffirmed the half-way Covenant. He was dismissed August, 1813, and afterward settled in West Haven.

Rev. MATTHEW R. DUTTON was born in Watertown, Conn., June 3, 1783, was graduated at Yale College, 1808, and was ordained in Stratford, September 20, 1814, having declined an urgent call from the Church in Portsmouth, N. H. Mr. Dutton continued pastor, universally esteemed and beloved, until the autumn of 1821, when he accepted the appointment of "Professor of Mathematics and Natural Philosophy," in Yale College. He died July 17, 1825.

When Mr. Dutton was called to the Church, its spiritual condition was very low. Various causes, long operating, had greatly adulterated the doctrinal belief of many members. Some of the most prominent had become believers in Universalism. The enforcement of discipline for errors in belief had become wholly impracticable. Mr. Dutton, as a condition of accepting the call, stipulated for an open thorough re-confession by the Church, of sound doctrine, and an assent to a solemn covenant to enforce discipline. The Confession of Faith and the Covenant now in use were at that time adopted, and only those who would assent to it were enrolled as members of the Church. In the catalogue of members, the asterisk is placed opposite the names of those who thus re-assented to the covenant. Mr. Dutton's ministry was blessed to the spiritual life and efficiency of the Church. In 1821, on one Sabbath, seventy persons were added to the Church.

Rev. JOSHUA LEAVITT, D.D., was born in Heath, Franklin County, Mass., Sept. 8, 1794, and was graduated at

Yale College, Sept., 1814. He was ordained over the Church in February, 1825, and was dismissed in 1828 to become Agent of the American Seamen's Friend Society in New York. After that he was connected with the religious and secular press, and also with several institutions of Christian benevolence and moral reform. He died in 1873.

Rev. THOMAS ROBBINS was born in Norfolk, Conn., August 11, 1777, entered Yale College in 1792. At the close of Junior year he left and joined the Senior Class in Williams College, where he was graduated in August, 1796. In September following he took the same degree, B. A., in his former class at Yale. In 1803, he was ordained Missionary of the Home Missionary Society, to the northern part of Ohio, where he labored until impaired health obliged him to return. In May, 1809, he was installed pastor over the Church in East Windsor, Conn., where he continued until 1827, when he was dismissed at his own request. In February, 1830, he was installed pastor over this Church, and on September 9th, the following year, he was dismissed. He removed to Metapoisett, Mass., where for fourteen years he remained pastor. Resigning his pastoral charge and office, he became Librarian of the Connecticut Historical Society, and lived in Hartford. He died at Colebrook, Sept. 13, 1856, in the 80th year of his age.

Rev. FREDERICK W. CHAPMAN was born in Canfield, Trumbull County, Ohio, Nov. 17, 1806, was graduated at Yale College in 1828, was ordained and installed pastor of this Church, September 5, 1832, and was dismissed

April 16, 1839. Subsequently he was settled over the Church at Deep River, and still later over the Church at Glastonbury. He died in 1876.

Rev. WILLIAM BOUTON WEED was born in New Canaan, March 22, 1811, and was graduated at Yale College, 1830. For several years after his graduation he devoted himself to teaching. He was converted under a sermon which he heard at Chilicothe, Ohio, from the text, "Be ye thankful." In 1836, he began the study of law, but abandoned it for the ministry and was ordained at Stratford, Dec. 4, 1839.

During his ministry, which was a most successful one, and one greatly blessed to the Church, Mr. Weed received many flattering calls to other pastorates. At length, thinking that a new field of labor might conduce to the invigoration of his enfeebled health, he accepted the invitation of the First Church in Norwalk, Conn., where he was installed June 27, 1855. He died Dec. 3, 1860.

Mr. Weed was held in prominent regard by the ministers and churches of the State, as a man of eminent ability, and his teachings are gratefully remembered by those who were permitted to receive them. A book of his sermons, to which is prefixed a biographical notice, has been published.

Rev. JOSEPH R. PAGE was born in New Brunswick, N. J., and at the time of his invitation to Stratford was pastor of the Presbyterian Church in Perry, Wyoming County, N. Y., where he was ordained, Feb. 6, 1839. He was installed pastor of this Church, Feb. 11, 1857. In October, 1858, he was dismissed, and soon assumed again the pastoral charge of his former Church in Perry. In June,

1868, he removed to East Avon, where for about five years he was acting pastor of the Presbyterian Church. In November, 1872, he removed to Rochester, where he served as missionary of the Rochester Presbytery. In February, 1875, he was installed pastor of the Presbyterian Church in Brighton, N. Y. In 1876 the degree of D.D. was conferred on him by Hamilton College.

Rev. BENJAMIN L. SWAN was born in Medford, Mass. July 31, 1813; entered College in the Junior Class, but was providentially hindered from completing the course; received the honorary degree of A. M. from Yale, in 1844. He was ordained pastor of the Church in Fair Haven, Conn., 1836; was installed pastor of the Church in Litchfield, Conn., in 1846. In September, 1858, he accepted the invitation of this Church, and was installed, October, 1858. He was dismissed in 1863. In the Spring of 1866 he became pastor of the Presbyterian Church in Oyster Bay, N. Y., which charge he held till the Fall of 1875, when domestic bereavement and physical prostration obliged him to resign his office. The subsequent five years he has passed at the West, chiefly preaching in Pontiac City, Ill., for the first Presbyterian Church there, but not intending again to become a settled pastor.

Rev. LEWIS CHARPIOT was installed pastor of this Church, May 25, 1864, and was dismissed April 12, 1866.

Rev. WILLIAM K. HALL was born in Boston, Mass., Nov. 4, 1836. He was graduated at Yale College, in 1859. His theological studies were pursued in New Haven, and in Berlin, Germany.

In October, 1862, he was ordained chaplain of the 17th Conn. Vols. He was installed pastor of this Church, Oct. 24, 1866. The relation was dissolved at his request, in May, 1872. In January, 1873, he accepted a call from the First Presbyterian Church in Newburgh, N. Y. He was chosen Moderator of the New York Synod in 1878, and in the following year was appointed by the Secretary of War as one of the Board of Visitors at West Point.

Rev. FRANK S. FITCH was born in Geneva, Ohio, February 24, 1846. Graduated from Oberlin College in 1870, and from Yale Theological Seminary in 1873. He was ordained and installed pastor of this Church, June 17, 1873. He resigned in October, 1878, and on Nov. 21st was installed as pastor of the Seventh Street Congregational Church, Cincinnati, Ohio.

Rev. S. H. DANA was installed pastor, March 12, 1879.

ELDERS AND DEACONS.

1. ELDERS.

But one ruling elder seems ever to have held office in this Church. He was PHILIP GROVES, who died in 1676. He was Deputy to the General Court for the town of Stratford, as early as 1652. In 1654 he was chosen "Assistant," and as such "was empowered to marry persons."

2. DEACONS.

The earliest named officers of this class on record are JOHN BIRDSEYE and TIMOTHY WILCOXSON. John Birdseye and his wife Philippa, came to New Haven from England, in 1636, and to Milford in 1639. They were living in Stratford, in 1641, when their son John was born, although he was baptized in Milford. They were dismissed from the Milford to the Stratford Church in 1649, and are the progenitors of all of that name in this vicinity. John Birdseye is referred to as *Deacon* in 1678. He was born in 1616, and died in 1690.

Timothy Wilcoxson is referred to as *Deacon* in 1678. He died in 1714.

3. Thomas Wells is mentioned as a deacon in 1707; died in 1721.

4. Robert Walker is next named as a deacon in 1722; died in 1743.

5. John Thompson is also mentioned as a deacon in 1722; died in 1765.

6. Job Peck is also styled "Deacon" on his grave stone, though no record of his appointment is extant, died in 1782.

7. Elnathan Wheeler, appointed in 1751, died 1761.

ADDITIONS TO THE CHURCH.

No connected or complete record exists of the accessions to the Church. The following facts have been obtained from different sources.

From 1676 to 1681, 35 were added.

From 1681 to 1700, 157 were added.

Of these in 1698, 22 were added, and one Sabbath in one of these years, 74 persons "stood up and avowed the covenant." In 1722-3, under the ministry of Mr. Gold, 60 persons were received into membership, and from 1740 to 1743, 31 persons were received.

Of these 31, it is interesting to know that 28 were under 30 years of age, and 16 of these under 21 years. This occurred during the "Great Awakening" of President Edwards' day.

During the whole period from 1722 to 1746, 324 were added to the Church.

In 1821, under the ministry of Mr. Dutton, 70 persons were received into the Church on one Sabbath.

In 1831, under the ministry of Mr. Chapman, there was a season of great religious interest, and upwards of 70 were at that time more or less awakened, but how many of these became members of the Church is not known.

In 1843-4, under the ministry of Mr. Weed, 43 were added to the Church.

In 1858, under the ministry of Mr. Page, 38 were added to the Church.

In 1867-8, 43 were added to the Church, under the ministry of Mr. Hall.

Under the ministry of Rev. Frank S. Fitch, there were 14 added to the Church in 1874, 43 in 1876, and 21 in 1877, on profession of faith.

FURNISHED FOR THE MINISTRY.

THIS CHURCH HAS GIVEN TO THE MINISTRY THE FOLLOWING-NAMED OF HER MEMBERS.

1. Benjamin Blakeman, son of first pastor, graduated at Harvard College, 1663. Closed a ministry at Malden, Mass., in 1678. Afterwards preached in Scarborough. Was subsequently in secular business.

2. Charles Chauncey, son of the pastor, was the first pastor of Bridgeport First, 1695-1714, when he died.

3. Isaac Chauncey, son of the pastor, was pastor at Hadley, Mass., 1696-1745, when he died.

4. Nathaniel Chauncey, nephew of the pastor, was the first recorded graduate of Yale College. Pastor at Durham (first pastor), 1711-1756, when he died.

5. John Beach, pastor of Congregational Church, Newtown, 1725-1732, and of Episcopal Church, Newtown, 1732-1782, when he died.

6. John Goodsell, first pastor of Church on Greenfield Hill, 1726-1756, when he died. His wife was Mary Lewis of Stratford, and they had fifteen children. He was twenty years old when settled. The Church was organized with twenty-six members, in connection with his settlement. Thirty-one were added that year on profession, and at the close of 1741 the Church numbered one hundred and sixty.

7. Jeremiah Curtis, first pastor at Southington, 1728-1755, and died there in 1795, aged eighty-nine.

8. Jonathan Ingersoll, pastor at Ridgefield, 1740-1778, when he died.

9. Mark Leavenworth, pastor at Waterbury, 1740-1797, when he died.

10. Nathan Birdseye, pastor at West Haven, 1742-1758, when from domestic considerations he retired to his homestead at Oronoque in Stratford, and died there in 1818, aged 103 years, 5 months, and 9 days. When 100 years old he made the ordaining prayer at the settlement of Mr. Dutton. He had 12 children, and at his death had had 76 grandchildren, 163 great grandchildren, and 7 children of the 4th generation—in all 258; of whom 206 were living at his death. Rev. Joseph P. Thompson, D.D., was a descendant.

11. David Judson, pastor of Congregational Church, Newtown, 1743-1776, when he died.

12. Hezekiah Gold, son of the pastor, was pastor at Cornwall, 1755-1790, when he died.

13. Eden Burroughs, pastor of a Church at South Killingly (organized in 1746 and now extinct), 1760-1763; pastor at Hanover, N. H., 1772-1809. Preached at Hartford, Vt., 1809-1813, when he died, aged 75. Rev. E. B. Foster was a descendant.

14. Andrew Judson, pastor at Eastford, 1778-1804, when he died.

15. Nehemiah Beach Beardsley, ordained 1816, died 1868.

16. Spencer F. Beard, ordained 1829, died at Andover, Mass., in 1876. Rev. Wm. H. Beard and Rev. Edwin S. Beard are his sons.

17. William Russell, ordained in 1842.

18. Phineas Blakeman, ordained in 1843.

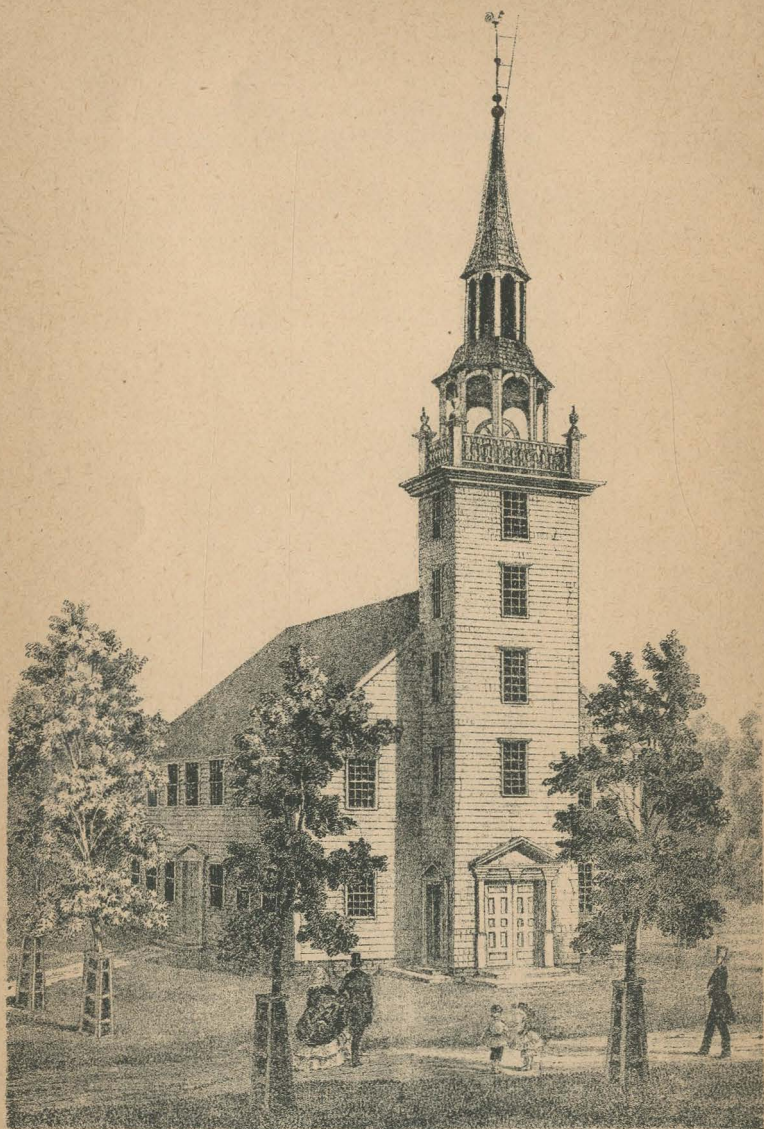

MEETING-HOUSES.

The first house for public worship was erected near what is now called "Sandy Hollow." This fact in reference to it is of interest, and deserves to be remembered. It possessed a bell, with which the people were summoned to worship. How it came to be thus favored is not known, for it was the only Church in all the colonies where the people were not called together by "drum, the blowing of shell or horn." In 1681 this house was removed and its materials sold at auction.

The second house for public worship was built on Watch House (now Academy) Hill. In 1689 this house was, by vote, fortified for the security of the women and children against any attack that might be made by the Indians.

The third house for public worship was built in 1743, and stood where the Academy now stands until 1785, when it was destroyed by lightning.

The fourth house for public worship was built in 1786. It occupied the site of the present house.

The fifth and present house for worship was dedicated on the 27th Oct., 1859.

FORM OF ADMISSION.

CONFESSION OF FAITH.

II. You believe the Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments to be the Word of God, and inspired by the Holy Spirit,¹ and that they contain in them all things necessary for our belief and practice in order to salvation.²

IV. You believe that our first parents, by eating the forbidden fruit, lost the moral image of God and fell into a state of sin and misery,¹ in consequence of which all their posterity are by nature destitute of true holiness.²

You believe in the immortality of the soul,¹ and that there will be a day of judgment, when the bodies of the just and the unjust shall be raised, and the whole human race appear before the bar of Christ;² the event of which will be, that the righteous shall enter into life eternal, but the wicked shall go away into everlasting punishment.³

Thus you believe.

(You will now enter into solemn covenant with God and this Church.)

COVENANT.

You do now, in the presence of God, and before angels and men, with seriousness, and, as you hope, with sincerity of soul, avouch the Lord Jehovah to be your Sovereign Lord, your Father, Redeemer, and Sanctifier, and your Supreme Good through Jesus Christ ; and you solemnly devote and give up yourself to his fear and service.

You engage, with dependence upon Divine Grace, in the most sacred ties to observe all God's commandments, seeking his glory by a conscientious performance of all Christian duties, and by a serious attendance on the ordinances of Christ to be enjoyed in His Church, and in this particular Church, until you shall be dismissed from the same.

You promise to submit to the government and discipline of this Church, and to support the same, according to the Gospel. Thus you promise and covenant.

(Here the ordinance of baptism, unless previously received, will be administered.)

In consequence of these professions and engagements, we, (here the members of the church will rise,) the members of this Church do promise that by Divine assistance we will treat you as a member of the same body with ourselves, watching over you for your good, with a spirit of meekness, love, and tenderness, and earnestly praying that God would dwell among us and command his blessing upon us, even life forevermore, through the merits and intercession of Jesus Christ, our Lord. Amen.

FORM FOR THE BAPTISM OF CHILDREN.

You, in presenting these children for baptism, profess yourselves believers in the covenant which God hath established with His people, promising to be a father to them and to their seed after them. You covenant, on your part, in the presence of God and these witnesses, to train these children in the nurture and admonition of the Lord, to instruct them in the knowledge of Divine Truth, as you may have opportunity, but especially in the way of salvation through Jesus Christ, and with Divine help to walk before them in the excellence of the Christian life. You do now solemnly dedicate them to God, the Father, Son, and Holy Ghost, to be His forever, promising by all means in your power, in reliance upon His grace, to seek their renewal and sanctification, that they may be prepared to take their places in full in Christ's visible church on earth, and at last in His glorified Church in Heaven. Do you thus profess and promise?

(The ordinance will here be administered.)

STANDING RULES.

1. All members of this Church, who have attained eighteen years, and are not under process of discipline by the Church, are entitled to vote in all its meetings.

2. The officers of this Church shall consist permanently of the Pastor and Deacons; to which shall be added by annual election from among the brethren, a Clerk, Treasurer, and a Standing Committee of five; also a Superintendent and Assistant Superintendent of the Sunday-school. The Pastor and Deacons shall be *ex officio* members of the Standing Committee.

The names of the Clerk, Treasurer, and Standing Committee, shall be presented to the Church by a Nominating Committee appointed for the purpose. The names of the Superintendent and Assistant Superintendent shall be presented to the Church by nomination of the Sunday-school. The election of officers shall be by ballot.

3. *Duties of Officers.*—It shall be the duty of the *deacons* to assist in the distribution of the elements at the celebration of the Lord's Supper; to take care of the poor; to visit the sick, and generally to afford such assistance to the pastor in the discharge of his parochial duties as the interest of the Church may require.

The *Clerk* shall keep a record of the proceedings of the Church, a list of members, and of baptized children, and note the changes by death, removal, marriage, entering all names in full as far as possible. He shall also make a report thereof at the annual meeting.

The *Treasurer* shall keep an account of all contributions and disbursements, and report the same at the annual meeting.

It shall be the duty of the *Standing Committee*:

To examine and propound for admission to the Church applicants for the same.

To inquire and examine as to any delinquent or unruly members of the Church, receiving any complaints that may be made against them, and if there is cause, reporting all such for the action of the Church.

To decide as to what objects of benevolence shall be annually presented to the Church.

To deliberate and determine in regard to all such matters connected with the good of the Church as shall seem to them reasonable and just.

4. *Membership*.—When a person proposes to unite with this Church, the same shall stand propounded two weeks; also when members of this Church request letters of dismission to other Churches, notice of their intention shall be given two weeks previous to any action upon the same.

Members of the Church in removing from the town are *expected* to transfer their membership to some other evangelical Church within one year from the time of their removal, and letters will not be granted to persons who have delayed applying for them for more than one year, unless reasons satisfactory to the Church shall be assigned.

Members of other Churches resident among us, who shall have communed with us for one year, will be *expected* to present letters of dismission from the Churches to which they belong, unless satisfactory reasons for the omission of such a step be presented to the Standing Committee.

5. The annual meeting of the Church shall be held on the day of the Preparatory Lecture next before the communion in May, when the officers of the Church shall be

elected in the order in which they stand in article 2 of these rules; after which any matters concerning the welfare of the Church may be introduced and transacted.

6. The Confession of Faith, Covenant, and Standing Rules, shall not be altered except by a two-thirds vote at any annual meeting, or a special meeting called for the purpose by notice from the pulpit.

STANDING APPOINTMENTS.

1. Public worship commences at 10.45 A.M., and at 2 or 7.30 P.M., throughout the year.
2. The Sabbath-school is held every Sabbath at the close of the morning worship.
3. The Sacrament of the Lord's Supper is administered the first Sabbaths in January, March, May, July, September, and November, in the place of the regular afternoon service.
4. A lecture preparatory to the Sacrament of the Lord's Supper is given on the Friday afternoon preceding the first Sabbath in January, March, and November, at 2 o'clock, and preceding the first Sabbath in May, July, and September, at 3 o'clock.
5. The ordinance of infant baptism is administered on the Communion Sabbaths of May, July, September, and November, immediately after the opening of the morning service.

N. B. Parents will give notice to the pastor of their intention to present children for baptism during the week preceding the designated Sabbath. Also the names of the children presented for baptism, together with those of their parents, should be given in writing to the pastor, that the record of them may be correct.
6. Meetings for prayer and social worship are held on Sunday evenings, and on Wednesday evenings, in the Conference Room.
7. The Concert of Prayer for Missions is attended on the evening of the first Sabbath of each month.
8. Contributions are annually made as follows, and

usually upon the second or third Sabbath of the designated month :

For the American Bible Society in January.

For the Tract Society in April.

For the Congregational Union in May.

For the Sunday-school Library in June.

For the American Board Com. For. Missions in July.

For the Home Missions in August.

For the American Seamen's Friend Society in October.

For the American Missionary Association in November.

A collection is also taken at the monthly concert of prayer for missions—which is equally divided between the Foreign and Home Missionary Societies. Also at each communion of the Lord's Supper a collection is taken, the proceeds of which are applied to the incidental expenses of the Church and to the support of the poor.

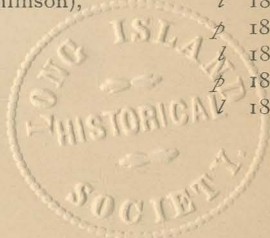
