Smimon (Haite) Hoyt, was born in Derbyshire, England, in 1595, and sailed on the Mary and John and landed in America, Sept., 6, 1628.. Had two children with him, Walter, age 10, and Nickolas. IN 1630

he was settled in Dorchester, Mass. and later moved to Scituate Mass. and married Susanna Smith

In 1640, Simon Hoyt moved to Windsor, Conn.

In 1651, Walter Hoyt, son of Simon, age 33 years, came to Norwalk and drew lot, 4a, on the old trail, now Ft Point street,

Bounded East by town highway,
West by common by backe coafe,
North by Nathaniel Sentions lot,
South by George Abbotts home lot.

He enlisted Aug. 12, 1776, and served as fifer in Capt.

Jabez Gregory's company, Luit, John Meads division, 9th reg.

Discharged Sept 23, 1776.

Reenlisted in same regiment, Oct. 24, 1776, and discharged Jan. 6, 1777.

In 1780 enlisted in Coast Guards under Capt M Lockwood, and discharged Jan. 1, 1781.

From records of Conn. men in the war of the Revolution, compiled under direction of the Adjutant General, Pages, 476-486-557-- 662.. Listed under Fife and Drum.
