

NORMAL SCHOOL OPENING.

Class of Twenty-One Registered To-Day--More Expected.

The Danbury Normal School opened this morning with an entering class of twenty-one juniors registered and several others expected during the early part of the month. There is but one change in the faculty of the institution, but several new teachers are at work in the Model Training schools.

The school assembled this morning for chapel exercises in the large assembly hall. After music Principal John R. Perkins made a brief address and the students separated to gather in their respective study rooms where work for the day was immediately assigned.
