PREAMBLE

We the full-time students of the LaCrosse Club, in cooperation with the WCSU Student Government Association and the Administration, do hereby establish this Constitution.

Article I - Name

The club name shall be "The Western Connecticut State University LaCrosse Club".

Article II - Purpose

The purpose of this organization is to give all full-time students the opportunity to learn the t echniques and rules of LaCrosse, and play LaCrosse on a club level.

Article III - Membership

The membership of the LaCrosse club will consist of full-time matriculated students.

Article IV - Officers

The elected officers shall be: President, Vice-President, Treasurer, and Secretary.

Article V - Duties of the Officers

The President shall-

- A. Act in accordance with the policies and provisions as provided in the Constitution.
 - B. Call to ordeer and preside over executive board meetings of the LaCrosse Club.
 - c. Be Chairman of the executive board.
- D. Call meetings of the LaCrosse Club with at least 24 hours notice.
- E. Be a voting member of the executive board.
- F. Be an official representive of the LaCrosse club.

3-0-0

The Vice-President shall-

- A. Act in accordance with the policies and provisions as provided in this Constitution.
- B. Assume the responsibility of the President in His/her abscence, re signation, or impeachment.
- C. Carry out all duties assigned to him/her by the club at the meetings and those assigned by the President.
- D. Act a s Chairperson for the publicity committee for all LaCrosse Club events.
- E. He a voting member of the executive Board.

The Treasurer shall-

- A. Act in accordance with the polocies and provisions as provided in this Constitution.
- B. Maintain and be responsible for accurate and up-to-date accounts of all budgeting expenditures and financial records.
- C. Serve as the Chairperson at ht the LaCrosse Club meetings in abcence of the President and Vice-President.
- D. Keep a record of all financial transactions and official papers pertaining to the LaCrosse Club.
- E. Be the signer of vouchers.
- F. Be a voting member of the executive board.

The Secretary shall-

- A. Ac t in accordance with the polocies and provisions as provided in this Constitutions
- B. Record the minutes with the meetings and submit a copy to any member upon request.
- C. Be in charge of all transactions and official papers pertaining to the LaCrosse Club.

- D. Be in charge of all written correspondence.
- E. Be a voting member of the executive board.

Article VI - Meetings

- I. LaCrosse shall meet at least once per semester during the academic year, except January.
- II. At least one Executive Board meeting will be **** held each month of the academic year except January where the power to appropriate monies and make any legislation to be upheld.

Article VII - Elections

- A. Candidates shall-backet submit petitions of endorsement consisting of at least 15 signatures from the LaCrosse Club.
- B. All petitions shall be submitted to the Electoral Committee no later than seven days prior to campaigning.
- C. Elections shall be held during the month of April at the discretion of the newly Electoral Committee.
- D.Newly elected officers shall assume office one calendar week after elections.
- E. Election results must be validated and posted.
- f. A special election shall be held in case of vacancy of an office.

Article VIII - Impeachment

Impeachment proceedings may be initiated against any elected officer if they do not fullfill their duties or violate the Constitution.

- A. Impeachment shall be initiated by a written petition signed by a majority of the LaCrosse Club.
- B. The petition shall be s ubmitted to the President, unless it is his or her impeachment proceedings, then to the Vice-President.
- C. The officer facing impeaching proceedings must:
 - 1. Be given a written statement of athe charges against him.
 - 2. Be given one calender week after receiving the notice to prepare his/her case.

- 3. Be given ample time on the floor to present his/her case.
- D. An affirmative 2/3 majority vote of the LaCrosse Club is required for dismissal.

Article IX - Commistees Faculty Advisor

The LaCrosse Club must have an advisor chosen form the full-time faculty of WCSU. The advisor is a non voting member.

AR ticle X - Committees

I. Members of the Executive Board shall be the elected positions: President Vice-President, Treasurer, and Secretary.

II. Committees:

- A. Publicity Committee- This committee is to gather and present to the LaCrosse Club information on speakers, class educational courses, fund-raisers and other activities.
- B. Activity Committee- This committee is to publicize all activities sponsored by the LaCrosse Club.
- C. Electoral Committe-

The committee shall consist of 5 persons appointed by the LaCrosse Club.

The committee shall be responsible for all elections and proceduress for the LaCrosse Club under the organization's advisor.

III. Any decision made by by the committee as must be presented to the Executive Board for approval.

Article XI- Amendments and By-laws

- I. This Constitution together with its by * laws shall constitute the operating basis of the LaCrosse.
- II. This Constitution may be amended by a majority vote of the LaCrosse Club with the approval of the WCSU SGA and the Administration of WCSU.

Article XII - Enabling Clause

This Constitution shall take effect by a majority of the LaCrosse Club and the approval of the WCSU SEA SGA and Administration. The LaCRosse Club will use Roberts Rules of Order as a guide.
